DECLARATION OF DISASTER FOR JOHNSON COUNTY

WHEREAS, the County of Johnson on the 3rd day of July 2018 is under imminent threat of severe damage, injury or loss of life or property resulting from:

THE THREAT OF WILDFIRES IN JOHNSON COUNTY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF JOHNSON COUNTY:

1. That a local state of disaster is hereby proclaimed for Johnson County pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
2. Pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Government Code, this Declaration of a local state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued for renewal by the Commissioners Court of Johnson County.
3. Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Government Code, this Declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk of Johnson County.
4. Pursuant to §418.108(i) of the Government Code, this Declaration bans the use of fireworks in Johnson County for 60 hours unless extended by the Governor.

This Proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance, **ORDERED THIS THE 3rd DAY OF JULY, 2018.**
