ESTABLISHING A SPEED LIMIT OF 25 MPH IN FISHERMAN'S PARADISE SUBDIVISION ON THE FOLLOWING ROADS: APACHE TRAIL, CHEROKEE COURT, CHEROKEE TRAIL, CIMARRON TRAIL, DUSTY TRAIL, EAGLES NEST, HILLTOP, INDIAN TRAIL, LAKESIDE DRIVE, LIVEOAK DRIVE, MOUNTAIN VIEW, OLD WAGON TRAIL, SCENIC VIEW COURT, SHINING STAR TRAIL, VALLEY VIEW AND VILLAGE DRIVE FOR THE SAFETY OF RESIDENTS AND CHILDREN IN JOHNSON COUNTY, TEXAS - PRECINCT #1

The Public Hearing was properly published in the Cleburne Times Review, on the County Web Page and on the bulletin board of the Johnson County Commissioners Court at the Johnson County Courthouse on Friday, May 2, 2014.

A motion was made by Commissioner Rick Bailey and seconded by Commissioner Jerry Stringer to approve "Establishing a Speed Limit of 25 mph in Fisherman's Paradise Subdivision on the following roads: Apache Trail, Cherokee Court, Cherokee Trail, Cimarron Trail, Dusty Trail, Eagles Nest, Hilltop, Indian Trail, Lakeside Drive, Liveoak Drive, Mountain View, Old Wagon Trail, Scenic View Court, Shining Star Trail, Valley View and Village Drive for the safety of residents and children in Johnson County, Texas Precinct #1." Said motion was approved by unanimous vote of the Commissioners Court on the 9th day of May, 2014.






