

HAMM CREEK PARK

JOHNSON COUNTY

GENERAL INFORMATION & RULES

- Campsite fees due at registration. CHECK OUT TIME for Camp Sites is 2 P.M. or renew by 9 a.m. depending on availability.
- Valid permit is required on the windshield of each vehicle.
- Overnight camping is available on a first-come, first-served basis. (No reservations at this time.)
- Maximum of two tents or one RV and one tent per site and up to eight people if space permits. Do not block roads or sites.
- Day Use guests must leave the Park by 10 p.m.
- Excess parking fee is required at campsites with more than two vehicles (including trailers).
- It is prohibited to consume or display an open container of an alcoholic beverage in public except in the person's immediate camp site or to sell alcoholic beverages in the Park.
- Quiet time is from 10 p.m. – 6 a.m.
- Excess noise and/or disturbing conduct are not permitted.
- Campsites must be kept clean. All litter must be disposed of in trash receptacles conveniently located throughout Park.
- Only one unit per site is permitted to hook up to utilities.
- GRAY WATER AND BLACK WATER MUST BE DISCHARGED ONLY AT DUMP STATION.
- All plants and wildlife are protected by law.
- No display or discharge of firearms or fireworks is allowed in the Park. No open fires when burn ban is in effect. No ground fires are permitted except in fire rings.
- Pets must be on a leash no longer than six feet and under control at all times. Pets are not allowed in buildings or on the beach. Pet owners must clean up after their pet.
- Horses are not permitted to be ridden or led on paved roadway, with the exception of designated horse crossings. Pedestrians on horseback riding trails shall yield the right-of-way to horses by standing quietly at the side of trail until horses have passed. Horses must have coggins papers.
- Gathering of firewood is prohibited.
- All terrain vehicles and dirt bikes may not be used in the Park, on or off the roadway. This prohibition does not apply to handicapped vehicles.
- SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK. No lifeguard on duty.
- Do not block ramp area.
- No boat clean-up, fishing or swimming allowed in the ramp area.
- Speed limit in Park area is 25 mph. Speed limit next to river is 10 mph.
- Please watch for children and wildlife.
- Failure to comply with these rules may result in eviction from the Park.
