**Order Abating Nuisance at 2000 Tepar Lane, Cleburne, 76031
Johnson County, Texas**

The Johnson County Commissioners Court met on September 28, 2009 in regular session and held a public hearing to consider abatement of a Nuisance at **2000 Tepar Lane, Cleburne, 76031, Johnson County, Texas.**

The Public Hearing was properly conducted after notice and citation to the property owner by Certified Mail. Said notice was delivered on June 15, 2009.

A motion was made by Commissioner Beeson and seconded by Commissioner Bailey to abate the nuisance by mowing the property, picking up the debris and transporting the debris to an appropriate disposal site and by securing the home. The said motion was approved by unanimous vote of the Commissioners Court.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that I, Roger Harmon, Johnson County Judge and we the Commissioners of Johnson County's four precincts do hereby affirm by this vote to abate the nuisance at **2000 Tepar Lane, Cleburne, 76031, Johnson County, Texas** by mowing the property, securing the home and removing debris to an appropriate disposal site. Furthermore, the Court authorizes County personnel to continue this action as necessary to prevent the recurrence of the nuisance and to further abate the nuisance at the described location. The Court further authorizes the County Attorney's Office to file appropriate documents to prosecute this matter and collect costs.
